**Formulary: Unrestricted** 



#### **Medication Class**

Sympathomimetic agent acting on both alpha and beta-adrenergic receptors

Positive inotrope and chronotrope, increasing cardiac output

Raises systolic blood pressure but lowers diastolic blood pressure

Bronchial smooth muscle relaxant

Mobilises liver glycogen, resulting in hyperglycaemia

#### **Presentation**

**Ampoule**: 1mg/10mL or 1:10,000

Ampoule: 1mg/mL or 1:1000

## **Storage**

Store at room temperature, below 25°C. Protect from light.

#### **Dose**

## Cardiac Arrest, Anaphylaxis, Bronchospasm

Blood Pressure, ECG, clinical response

## **Pregnancy**

1<sup>st</sup> Trimester: Safe to use
 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester: Safe to use
 3<sup>rd</sup> Trimester: Safe to use

# **Breastfeeding**

Safe to use

#### Comments

Avoid repeated IM injections to the same site as may cause ischaemia and necrosis
